Caloundra City Private School's OSHC aims to provide quality care for all children attending our School and for those in the wider community.


Our Service Educators are **Vanessa Smith** and **Maddy Yates** together with their team at CCPS wish everyone a very happy holiday.

All bookings are to be done in advance through the My Family Lounge casual booking calendar, or via the casual calendar phone app.

Bookings are essential. All bookings are taken via the My Family Lounge system. This booking system can be found at the bottom of the page on

our website. Click here to book. The process to book is as follows:

Sign in to the My Family Lounge portal (if you have previously registered)

Select 'add casual booking' and follow the prompts

Click 'complete registration' once you receive the confirmation email

Create a password

Complete your personal details, then select 'add child'

Select 'add casual booking' and follow the prompts



Vacation Care fees

- Normal in-house pre booked days: \$57.00
- Excursion/Incursion days: charged at an additional cost where stated

Booking T&Cs

- Non-attendance on booked days will incur the normal fee for that day.
- Please cancel through My Family Lounge casual booking calendar or the phone app 24 hours in advance to avoid being charged.
- Positions are limited, however, a waitlist will be used when necessary. Please contact Vanessa Smith at oshc@ccps.qld.edu.au if you have any questions.
- Please note that fees are subject to change depending on the activities offered on the day.

If you haven't used our OSHC service in the last 6 weeks please go on to your MyGov account and re-enrol.

- Closed in shoes
- Change of clothes just in case
- Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea unless program indicates otherwise. Fruit is readily available each day.

Medication and illness

If your child is required to take any form of medication whilst at Caloundra City Private School's OSHC please complete a **medicine** administration form which can be filled out on the first day of Vacation Care.

Place the medication in a snap lock bag; all medication MUST be in original packaging. Label the snap lock bag with child's name and time the medication is to be administered. Please give the bag and form to the Educator.

Any child with an **infectious condition** is **not to attend** Caloundra City Private School's OSHC.

If a child is deemed to be displaying symptoms of an infectious condition or to be unwell to participate in activities due to their health, parents will be contacted and the child is to be picked up as soon as possible.
